

# NAPA Policy and Student Code of Conduct Agreement

- The Prom is a very special evening for Jr. and Sr. students and their guests. The attire is formal. For girls, short or long “fancy” dresses are appropriate. The boys should wear a tux, suit, or coat and tie.
- All Students and Guests are **REQUIRED** to ride the chartered bus to the event, and they are **REQUIRED** to return to New Albany High School on the same bus. This is a NAPA requirement due to liability insurance.  
If a parent is working as a chaperone, his/her child will still be required to ride the bus. The **ONLY** exception is due to an emergency.
- Any Student or Guest who has a prom ticket but has NOT arrived at **New Albany High School** by departure time, their parent/guardian will be immediately notified of their absence. **THE BUSES WILL LEAVE ON TIME.**
- Any special needs (medical, dietary, etc.) should be brought to the attention of the NAPA committee at the time of delivery of Parental Consent forms to the prom coordinator. It is the parent or legal guardian’s responsibility to inform the Prom Coordinator.
- Anyone arriving with alcohol or drugs in their possession, or showing SIGNS of being under the influence will NOT be allowed to attend Prom. Violator’s parents will be called for immediate pick up. In the event the parent cannot be reached, the student or students will be turned over to security or law enforcement.

New Albany Prom is **Alcohol and Drug Free** with a **ZERO tolerance** policy.

- Inappropriate or lude dancing will not be tolerated
- Guests: GUESTS are expected to abide by the same Code of Conduct as New Albany High School students. Age range: 9th Grade - 19 Years old. Guests must complete the registration form entirely and attach required documents. ( Anyone NOT enrolled as a student of the New Albany School District must attach a copy of their Driver’s license to their registration form. Failure to submit completed forms voids their Guest Ticket) Your NAHS Student Host is responsible for your behavior. If you are disciplined or removed from the prom for any reason, your NAHS Host will also be disciplined or removed.

The New Albany Parent Association reserves the right to refuse guests for various reasons, including but not limited to criminal records and poor school discipline records.
