Prom General Information

Dear Parents/Guardians of Junior and Senior Students:

We are rapidly approaching the end of 2023, and that means Prom is right around the corner! This document contains all the information your Junior or Senior will need to plan for a memorable celebration. Prom will be held Saturday evening, March 30, 2024 at The Jefferson in Oxford. This formal celebration features a sit-down dinner, music, and dancing. Prom tickets are \$85 per person which includes dinner, transportation to and from The Jefferson, entertainment, and a prom t-shirt.

Please read the information below carefully with your student and complete the required registration forms if your student plans on attending Prom. Registration forms include:

Prom reservations will be sold from December 1, 2023 until March 8th, 2024. Your student may pay the total \$85.00 fee all at one time, or he/she may follow the payment plan below. All payments/forms should be returned to Stephanie Gregg or Allie Speck. Forms may be turned in beginning December 1 2023. No forms will be accepted after March 8, 2024.

We ask you to pay by check or money order and put the payment and all signed forms in a sealed envelope with the student's name on the outside. We will no longer be writing receipts for cash.

- Initial Deposit Due By: Monday, December 18 (\$25.00/per person- **NON-REFUNDABLE**)
(This will guarantee a reservation to the prom for your child and his/her guest.)
- 2nd Payment Due By: Friday, February 2 (\$20.00 per person)
- 3rd Payment Due By: Friday, February 16 (\$20.00 per person)
- 4th and Final Payment Due By: Friday, March 8 (\$20.00 per person)

NAPA Policy/Student Agreement

NAPA Prom will be **Alcohol and Drug Free** with a **ZERO tolerance** policy.

- Anyone arriving with alcohol or drugs in his/her possession will not be allowed to attend prom. Anyone that shows **SIGNS** of alcohol or drugs will not be allowed to board the buses. Violator's parents will be called for immediate pick up. In the event the parent cannot be reached, the student or students will be turned over to security that will be present.
- For students who have purchased a prom ticket but have not arrived at **New Albany High School** by the appointed time, their parent/guardian will be called.
- All students and dates **MUST** ride the chartered bus to the event, and they **MUST** return to New Albany High School on the bus. There will be no exceptions for this. If a parent is working as a chaperone, his/her child will still be required to ride the bus.
- Any special needs (medical, dietary, etc.) should be brought to the attention of the NAPA committee. It is the parent or legal guardian's responsibility to inform NAPA.
- The Prom is a formal affair and a very special evening for everyone. Formal attire is required throughout the evening. Girls' fancy dresses may be short or long. Boys should be in a tux or suit and tie. Please remember that if you as a parent have to question it, then it is probably not appropriate for a school dance event.
